Starter-questions for discussion

- how fast are you moving?

Draw near (v19-25) ↑

- what we have (v19-21)
 - authorized access
 - guaranteed access
- what we should do (v22-25)
 - draw near (faith)
 - hold fast (hope)
 - stir up (love)

Don't fall away (v26-31) ↓

- rejection of truth
- fury of fire

Press on (v32-39) ⇨

- you did endure (v32-35)
- you need to endure (v36-39)

? which of these three do you find your weakest / strongest – drawing near, holding fast, stirring up?

? it's a staggering thing that through Christ we have authorized access into God's presence. Do you find you take this for granted? If so, why?

? do you find it awkward striking up a 'spiritual' conversation after the service, or when meeting up with other Christians? If so, why?

? what do you think your split-times would look like over your Christian race so far? Have there been times when you've been going for it more than now?

? how does this warning about the danger of falling away make you feel?

? what is the biggest cost to you in following Christ? What makes it worth paying?

? if you're not a Christian, which direction are you moving in at the moment spiritually? Towards God or away from God?
