Mark 15:40-16:8 HE HAS RISEN!

*Believe and tell others the astonishing news
that Jesus really has been raised from death to life*

- loss of hope

DEFINITELY DEAD (15:40-47)

- dead (v40-45)
 - o the women
 - o the member
 - o the centurion
 - o the governor

- buried (v46-47)

REALLY RAISED (16:1-7)

- dead ends (v1-3)
 - o 'the women went to the wrong tomb'

- o 'the women hallucinated what they were expecting'

- o 'the resurrection was made up by the early church'

- solid evidence (v4-7)
 - o empty tomb
 - o physical appearances

ABSOLUTELY ASTONISHING (16:8)

- trembling and astonishment
 - o who is Jesus?
 - o why did he come?
 - o what does it mean to follow him?
- fear and silence
