

Things not to do Things to do

Don't have a Bible out, at least to start with and don't ever ask someone to read out loud.

Avoid being overheard.

Don't jump to the assumption that your guest is interested in Christianity.

Don't worry about:

- a) What you say...they remember the Word!
- b) Questions...note them down and seek help if you need

Don't assume you know what is going on in their heads! Stick to your task and <u>listen</u>...because <u>God</u> is at work.

Don't assume they will automatically want to meet again.

Pray...lots

Finish with "Did you enjoy that? Would you like to meet again?"

Be flexible...expect cancellations!

Realise you are a living example of "church"...look for opportunities to serve your friend e.g. "I was thinking about you....this book....this CD..."

Remember PEARLS;

- P Pray more than you are doing.
- E Enjoy each study
 You will grow learning and praying.
- A Agonise
 Read up/prep/pray more! It's not "just a coffee".
- R Rejoice!
 You will see the mustard seed grow as God works.
- L Learn
 Take a note of what works...and listen.
- S Submit
 You are doing the Lord's work ask God
 to refine you.

Ask someone else – the average is four!
