### **God rescues his people BY judgement** (11:1-10; 12:29-42)

- nightmarish judgement

- necessary judgement

- remembering rescue (12:43-13:16)

- Passover (12:43-51) <sup>3</sup>  
(Am a saved sinner)

- Unleavened Bread (13:3-10) <sup>4</sup>  
(Be godly)

- Consecration of Firstborn <sup>5</sup>  
(13:1-2,11-16)  
(Commit to the Lord)

### **God rescues his people FROM judgement**

- experiencing rescue (12:1-28)
  - God provided the Passover Lamb <sup>1</sup>
  - God commanded the people what they had to do <sup>2</sup>
