## In all of life

---

- going for it <sup>1</sup>

<sup>11</sup> *Never be lacking in zeal, but keep your spiritual fervour, serving the Lord.*

## The GREATNESS of God

- the LORD is God <sup>2</sup>

<sup>4</sup> *Hear, O Israel: the LORD our God, the LORD is one.*<sup>5</sup> *Love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength.*

- the LORD is great <sup>3</sup>

<sup>13</sup> *'When you bring injured, lame or diseased animals and offer them as sacrifices, should I accept them from your hands?' says the LORD.*  
<sup>14</sup> *'Cursed is the cheat who has an acceptable male in his flock and vows to give it, but then sacrifices a blemished animal to the Lord. For I am a great king,' says the LORD Almighty, 'and my name is to be feared among the nations.*

- the LORD is glorious <sup>4</sup>

<sup>3</sup> *And they were calling to one another: 'Holy, holy, holy is the LORD Almighty; the whole earth is full of his glory.'* <sup>4</sup> *At the sound of their voices the doorposts and thresholds shook and the temple was filled with smoke...*<sup>8</sup> *Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying, 'Whom shall I send? And who will go for us?' And I said, 'Here am I. Send me!'*

## The GRACE of God

- burnt offering <sup>5</sup>

<sup>9</sup> *and the priest is to burn all of it on the altar. It is a burnt offering, a food offering, an aroma pleasing to the LORD.*

- Christ as the burnt offering <sup>6</sup>

<sup>6</sup> *with burnt offerings and sin offerings you were not pleased.* <sup>7</sup> *Then I said, "Here I am – it is written about me in the scroll – I have come to do your will, my God."*

- us as the burnt offering <sup>7</sup>

*'Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God – this is your true and proper worship.'*

## The GOVERNMENT of God

- Jesus is Lord <sup>8</sup>

<sup>36</sup> *'Therefore let all Israel be assured of this: God has made this Jesus, whom you crucified, both Lord and Christ.'*

- under new management <sup>9</sup>

<sup>9</sup> *if you declare with your mouth, 'Jesus is Lord,' and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.*
