# **PRIDE AND HUMILITY** Can I really do it all?

## - Pride and Humility<sup>1</sup>

<sup>5</sup>Clothe yourselves with humility toward one another for God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble. (1 Peter 5:5)

## Be Humble- We're finite

#### - Finite time

<sup>6</sup>A voice says, "Cry! And I said, "What shall I cry?" All flesh is grass, and all its beauty is like the flower of the field. <sup>7</sup>The grass withers, the flower fades when the breath of the LORD blows on it; surely the people are grass. (Isaiah 40:6-7)

## - Finite power

<sup>12</sup> Who has measured the waters in the hollow of his hand and marked off the heavens with a span, enclosed the dust of the earth in a measure and weighed the mountains in scales and the hills in a balance? (Isaiah 40:12)

## - Finite control

<sup>13</sup> Come now, you who say, "Today or tomorrow we will go into such and such a town and spend a year there and trade and make a profit"— <sup>14</sup> yet you do not know what tomorrow will bring. What is your life? For you are a mist that appears for a little time and then vanishes. <sup>15</sup> Instead you ought to say, "If the Lord wills, we will live and do this or that." <sup>16</sup> As it is, you boast in your arrogance. All such boasting is evil. (James 4:13-16)

### Finite impact

<sup>15</sup> Behold, the nations are like a drop from a bucket, and are accounted as the dust on the scales... (Isaiah 40:15, 17)

## - Finite knowledge

<sup>13</sup> Who has measured the Spirit of the Lord, or what man shows him his counsel? <sup>14</sup> Whom did he consult, and who made him understand? Who taught him the path of justice, and taught him knowledge, and showed him the way of understanding? (Isaiah 40:13-14)

# Have Dignity- from the infinite one

- Nothing else gives true dignity
- God humbly gives dignity<sup>2</sup>
  - To all humanity

<sup>27</sup> So God created man in his own image, in the image of God he created him; male and female he created them. (Gen. 1:27)

• To his people

<sup>10</sup>Behold, the Lord God comes with might, and his arm rules for him; behold, his reward is with him, and his recompense before him. <sup>11</sup>He will tend his flock like a shepherd; he will gather the lambs in his arms; he will carry them in his bosom, and gently lead those that are with young. (Isaiah 40:10-11).
