A Psalm of David, when he fled from Absalom his son.

- <sup>1</sup>O LORD, how many are my foes! Many are rising against me;
- <sup>2</sup> many are saying of my soul, "There is no salvation for him in God."
- <sup>3</sup> But you, O LORD, are a shield about me, my glory, and the lifter of my head.
- 4 I cried aloud to the LORD, and he answered me from his holy hill.
- <sup>5</sup> I lay down and slept; I woke again, for the LORD sustained me.
- <sup>6</sup> I will not be afraid of many thousands of people who have set themselves against me all around.

<sup>7</sup>Arise, O LORD!

Save me, O my God!

For you strike all my enemies on the cheek; you break the teeth of the wicked.

<sup>8</sup> Salvation belongs to the LORD; your blessing be on your people!
