## Habakkuk 1:12-2:5

- 1 <sup>12</sup> Are you not from everlasting, O LORD my God, my Holy One? We shall not die.
- O LORD, you have ordained them as a judgment, and you, O Rock, have established them for reproof.
- <sup>13</sup> You who are of purer eyes than to see evil and cannot look at wrong,
- why do you idly look at traitors and remain silent when the wicked swallows up the man more righteous than he?
- <sup>14</sup> You make mankind like the fish of the sea, like crawling things that have no ruler.
- <sup>15</sup> He brings all of them up with a hook; he drags them out with his net; he gathers them in his dragnet;
