<sup>1</sup> God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble.<sup>2</sup> Therefore we will not fear though the earth gives way, though the mountains be moved into the heart of the sea,<sup>3</sup> though its waters roar and foam, though the mountains tremble at its swelling. *Selah*
