Building a People: Justice and Generosity Nehemiah 5

A Great Outcry (v1–5)

- Large families and famine v1–2
- Mortgaging land to buy food v3

- High tax v4–5

A Great Justice (v6–13)

- Injustice provokes righteous anger (v6)
- Justice means fearing the Lord (v9)

- The unjust shall be shaken out (v13)

- Jesus' justice is greater ¹

A Great Generosity (v14–19)

- Generosity is a long-term endeavour (v14)
- Generosity comes from fear of the Lord (v15)
- Generosity is the giving up of entitlement (v18)
- Jesus' generosity is greater
