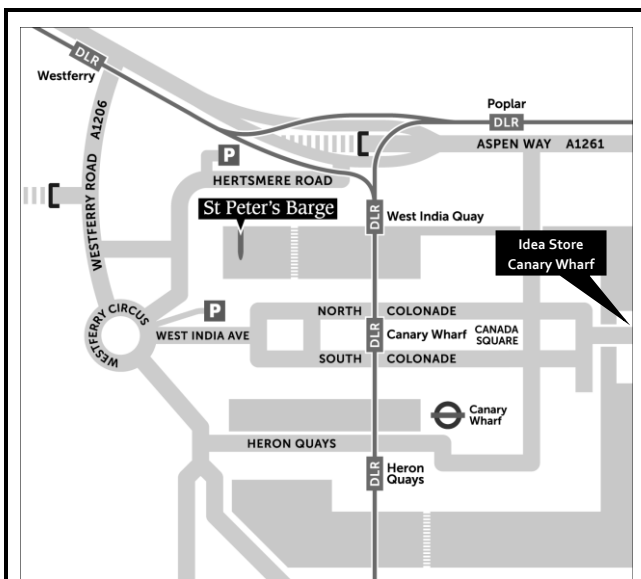

## 'Is God good?' Job 34

### THE ACCUSATION | God is unjust (v1-9)

- Elihu's concern (v2-4)
- Job's claims (v5-9)

### THE TRUTH | God is perfectly just (v10-37)

- God does not do wrong (v10-12) <sup>2</sup>
