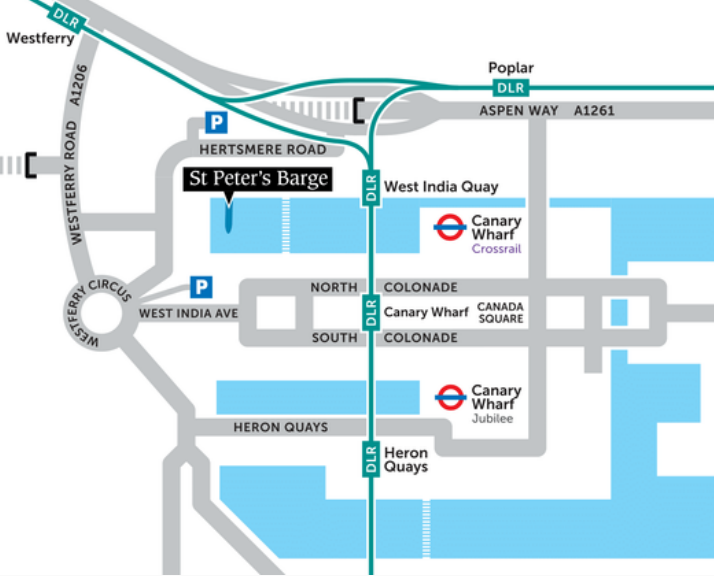

### Nearest DLR stations

## Parking

You can park for free on Sundays in front of Cannon Workshops on Hertsmere Road except those spaces marked "Reserved" or "Zipcar", but only if you have provided us with your car make, model and registration beforehand. Other free options are Garford Street and Milligan Street (both ca. 10 mins walk).

Cabot Square Car Park and Westferry Circus Car Park, £4.80 for up to 2 hrs (3 hrs free on weekends with purchases at Canary Wharf), 5 mins walk.


Multi-storey car park on Hertsmere Road, £5.00 for up to 2 hrs, 5 mins walk.

# SUNDAY SERVICE

Our Sunday service happens at 11 am on the Barge. The service itself lasts about 75 mins. We listen to what God says as the Bible is explained, pray to him, and praise him in Christian hymns and songs. At the end, there is time for questions and a chance to meet others.

# GROUPS AND ACTIVITIES

## Sunday School & Crèche

During the service, we run a Sunday School for children up to Year 6 in London Docklands Museum. Both back rooms on the Barge are available for Crèche (the lower room, and the office room with a barrier across the entrance). The Crèche is parent-run – a parent will need to supervise their child.

## Communion



Once a month, we share bread and wine as we remember Jesus' death on the cross for us.

## Guest Sundays



Although anyone is welcome any Sunday, we have some Sunday services in which the talk is particularly geared with those in mind who wouldn't normally come to church. These are indicated on the left. Do invite others along!

## Growth Groups

Growth Groups provide an opportunity for Christians who are part of the Barge Sunday Church to study the Bible, and pray together. It's a great way to get to know others better and to get to know God better. Groups meet 7.30-9 pm on Wednesdays. Growth Groups include a special focus on prayer once a month. There is a choice of mixed or single-sex groups.

There is also a Tuesday morning Growth Group for women at 10 am on the Barge. And there are Sunday options for those who can't make any of the other days.

## Weekend away & Day away

We have a Weekend Away and Day Away every year with a guest speaker. It's a great way to get to know other church members better, to look at God's Word together, and to rest and relax away from central London.
