- Allegorical – What does this tell us about Jesus?

## The Lord is a mighty warrior... (1-6)<sup>1</sup>

- God's character (1:2–3a)<sup>2</sup>

- Anagogical – How does this relate to eternity?

- God's power (1:3b–6)

## ... who destroys his enemies... (8–12a, 14)

- The principle: The Lord destroys his adversaries (1:8)

- The example: Nineveh (9–12a, 14)

- → How do we read the bible?
  - Literal History and Prophecy

... and delivers those who seek refuge in him. (7, 12b–13, 15)

- The principle: The Lord delivers those who take refuge in him (1:7)<sup>3</sup>

- The example: Judah (12b–13, 15)<sup>4</sup>
