Christmas Outreach

- We have delivered ~500 evangelistic winter *Life* magazines in the area and to people we know. Inside are invites to our Christmas services (see left).
- We had our family Christmas Cracker on Sunday and had a new family visit having received the magazine through their door.
- We have our Carol Service on Sunday 22nd December.

Discipleship

- We finished our sermon series on Acts in November, which has challenged us to be a mission-oriented church trusting in the empowering of God's Spirit.
- We're continuing looking at Ephesians in our Growth Group, thinking about what it is to be God's grace-formed community.
- In December we will be looking at John 1 together on Sundays and we will be starting a series in the Psalms in the New Year.

Trustees and Members

- We are thankful to be in the process of appointing two Interim Trustees for the church, which will restore us to the appropriate number. They are a couple with pastoral ministry experience and will provide very helpful support for Stephen and Rhiannon.
- We want and need our membership to grow. We pray that as we seek to reach the community people will become Christians and join, but we also would love for committed Christians to join the work of the harvest here.

Prayer Points:

- Pray for people to respond to the magazines and invitations to the church, especially that they would respond to the gospel.
