1,000 years: Literal or not?

Context: The structure of 19:6-21:8

When does is the millennium? Now (Amill / Post-mill) or Future (Pre-mill)

19:6-10 – **Invitation to the wedding**

19:11-16 – The Rider on the white horse coming to judge

19:17-21 – **The last battle (I) – c.f. Eze 39**

20:1-3 – 1,000 years: Satan bound

20:4-6 – 1,000 years: Saints reign

20:7-10 – **The last battle (II) – c.f. Eze 38**

20:11-15 – The great white throne and final judgment

21:1-8 – **The Bride:** the new heaven and new earth

*19:17-21 – **The last battle (I) – c.f. Eze 39***

***DELAY** - 20:1-6 – 1,000 years: Satan bounds, saints reign*

*20:7-10 – **The last battle (II) – c.f. Eze 38***

1. Our Hero arrives... (19:11-16)

2. ...to crush those who trample on his Bride... (19:17-21)

3. ...so that his Bride will reign with him (20:1-6)
