

Listen to Him

Mark 9:2-13

1. The glory is real, and it belongs to Jesus — vv.2–4

3. The road from glory runs straight through suffering — vv.9–13

2. The voice cuts through the fog: “Listen to him” — vv.5–8

Questions for reflection:

1. When suffering comes, am I tempted to think God has let me down, rather than trusting that Jesus is still glorious and still in control?

2. Where in my life might Jesus be saying, “Listen to me,” but I’m finding his words difficult because they challenge my comfort or the plans I’ve made?
